


Delayed luggage

A NOTE FROM THE CEO...

Members,

At TMCU, we have grown accustomed to the pace of change, but I have to say in recent months we have been busier than ever. So here are a few updates for you – Our I.T. strategy is really coming together well. In mid March we will roll out an upgrade to our core banking software, which will allow us to serve you more efficiently and it will set the platform for additional products and services to be rolled out in the months ahead – products like Apple Pay and Google Pay, and access to instant transfers via the New Payments Platform as well. Our members have been increasingly asking us to enable those services, so it will be our pleasure to deliver them to you. Please note, there will be an overnight outage on Friday 15th March as our systems are brought up into the new environment, but expect to be back online on the morning of the 16th March. Please keep an eye on our facebook page for updates on the rollout. Additionally, we are working hard to prepare an upgraded mobile banking App for your convenience and it is scheduled to go live on 28th March, so keep an eye out for that and let us know what you think!

The usage of cheques has continued to fall as consumers move to more secure, digital payments channels. At the same time, our 3rd party payments providers have notified TMCU that they will cease processing of cheques and deposit books through the NAB. The result of this means that TMCU will no longer be able to support member cheques, corporate cheques and deposits made through the NAB using encoded deposit books, effective 30th April 2024. We have been in contact with regular cheque users and will continue to support them adapting to alternative payments methods. If you need assistance in readying for this change, please contact the Credit Union and we will be delighted to help.

As you may recall from previous CEO's notes, TMCU is very active in supporting community organisations and events. Recently we made a donation to Bike North / Lug & Carrie to help them prepare an ebike trial for interested families. The goal is to assist members of the public to ditch the second car for a month and use an e-cargo bike instead for those local trips to the grocers or to take the kids to school. Better for health, and better for the environment. I'm proud to say that TMCU was able to sponsor a women's shed, to enable support and activities to women at risk of domestic abuse and homelessness. A worthwhile initiative indeed.

If you weren't at the 2023 Annual General Meeting, you might have missed out on some important news involving our Board. Anthony Dann, our committed and long serving Chair decided to leave the Board in what must have been a very difficult decision. The AGM was an emotional night as we farewelled Anthony, and I want to publicly thank AD for his service to Members and dedication to continual improvement at all levels of the organisation. Vince Taranto, one of our very experienced directors, was elected as the next Chair, and we know you will join us in thanking Vince for taking on the critical role of Board Chair.

Speaking of AGMs, the 2024 AGM will mark our 60th year of serving Members. So we will take a moment to reflect on the Credit Union's story in a night of fun at our diamond anniversary at the Royal Automobile Club in Macquarie St Sydney. If you would like to join us we would be delighted to have you there. This Credit Union is all about Member participation and so we are looking to a fantastic evening. Details will be sent to Members who have elected to receive notices of meetings, so do keep an eye out and we will see you there!

CHEQUE SERVICES IMPORTANT CHANGES

Cheque usage has significantly declined with an increasing number of Australians moving towards other faster and more secure payment methods. Transport Mutual was notified about the termination of our cheque issuer arrangement with our third-party provider. Given the rapid decline in cheque usage, we were unable to establish a new cheque product arrangement. Consequently, all cheque facilities will be discontinued from 30th April 2024. For security reasons, please destroy your cheque or deposit books.

What implications does this have for our members who were using these facilities?

Members will no longer be able to:

- Issue cheques using a Member Cheque Book
- Issue Corporate Credit Union cheques
- Make deposits with a Member Deposit Book

Alternative ways to continue banking

Your account and BSB numbers will not change. Transport Mutual offers many convenient and safer ways for you to bank with us including:

- Internet Banking
- Mobile Banking
- Bank@Post with 3,500 locations

If I receive a cheque after 30 April 2024, where can I bank it?

You'll still be able to deposit cheques at more than 3,500 Australia Post locations across the country, thanks to our partnership with Australia Post. To make a deposit, you'll need your Visa Debit Card and PIN to process the transaction. Please allow up to 7 business days for your cheque to clear.

Getting a Visa Debit Card to transact on your account

If you need a replacement Visa Debit Card to use at Australia Post, you can request this by contacting the team at TMCU.

What should I do if I receive cheques on a regular basis?

Consider having funds directly credited to your bank account by providing the cheque issuer with your BSB and account number.
